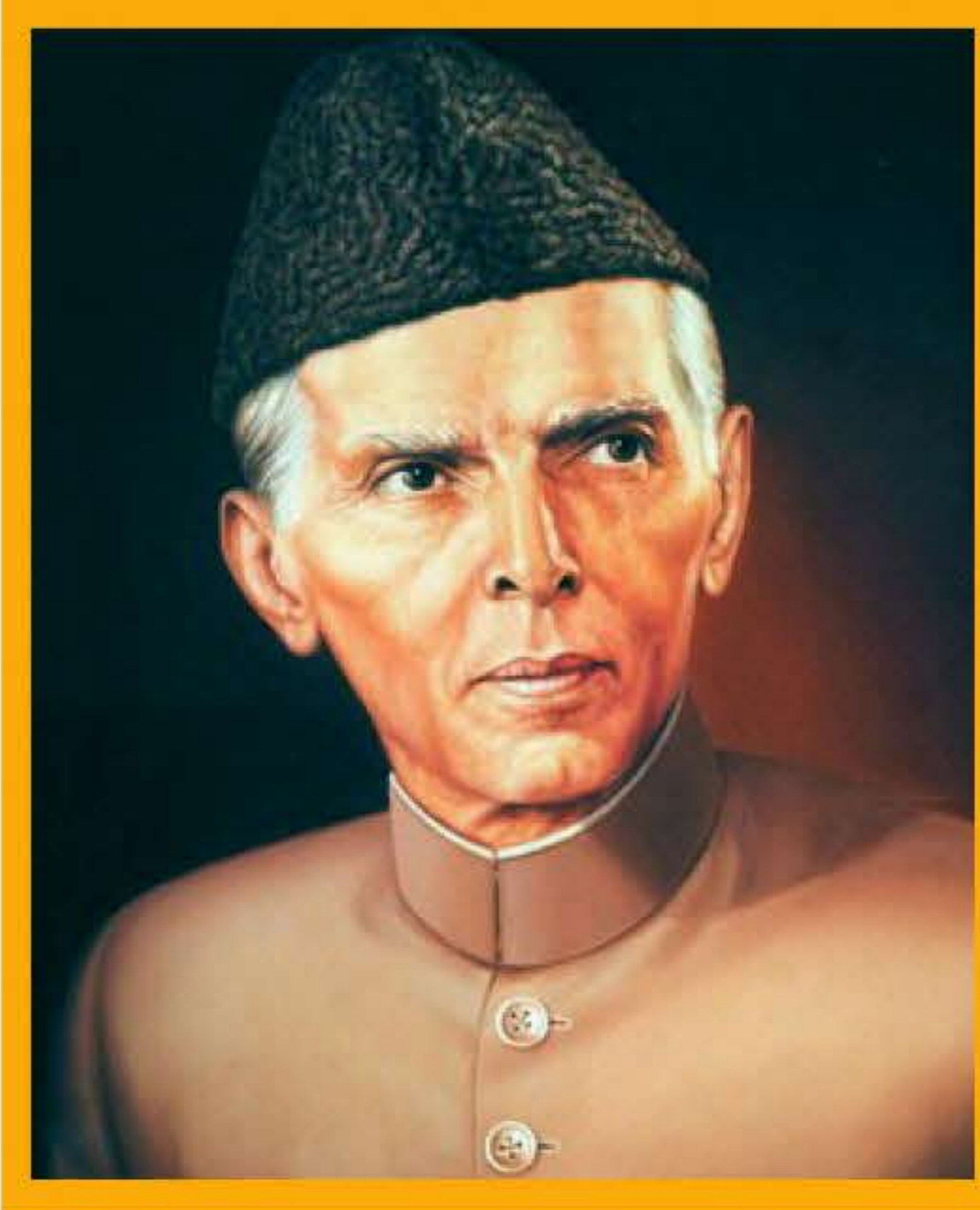

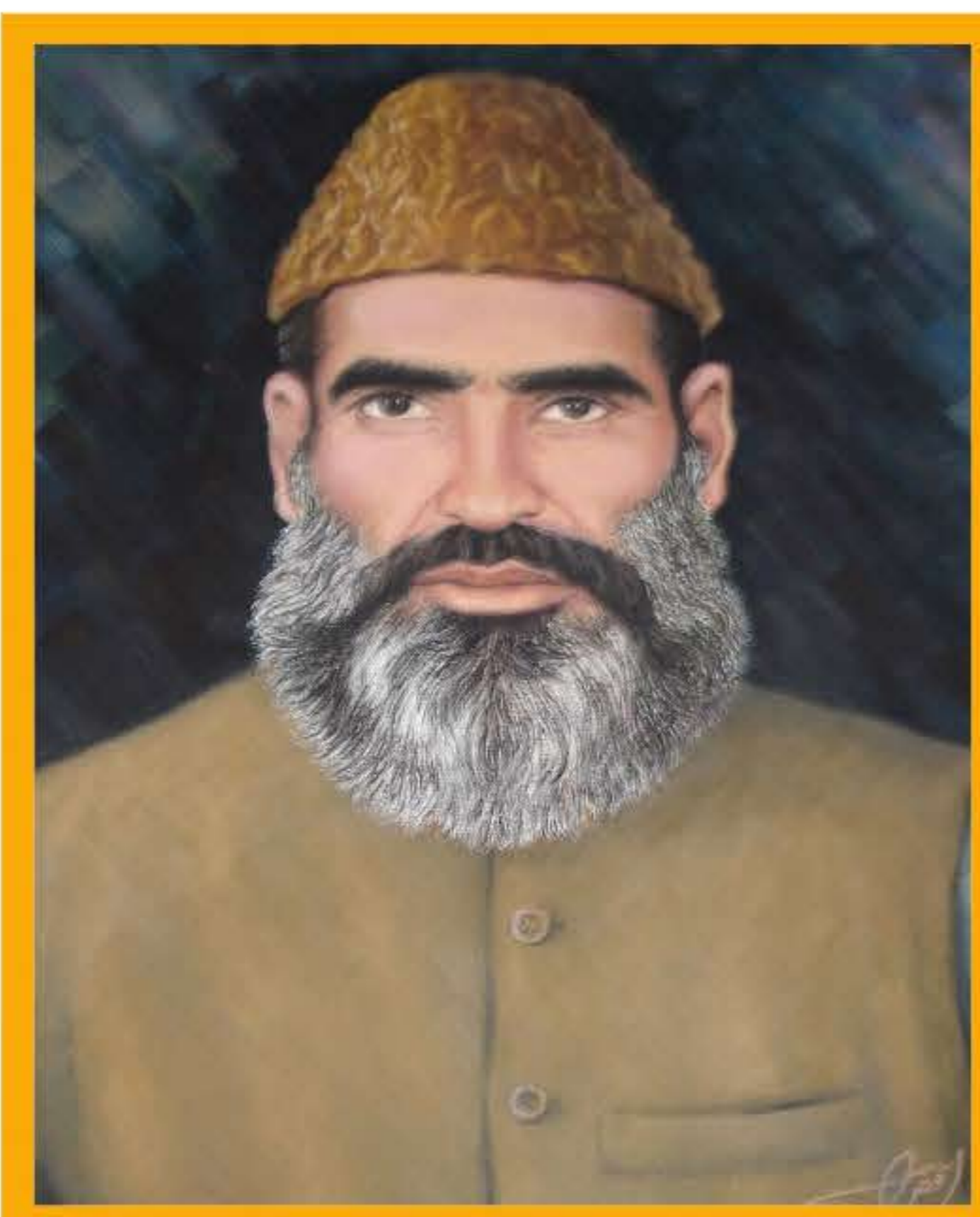

Ali Fatimah Teaching Hospital

Ali Fatimah Hospital (AFH) is a Madinah Foundation welfare project that began in 2017 with the goal of providing low-cost health care to the people of Lahore and the surrounding areas. The Hospital is a Non-Profit Organization, as defined by Section 2(36) of the Income Tax Ordinance of 2001. Pakistan Medical Commission has recognized Ali Fatimah Hospital as a teaching hospital attached with Abu Umara Medical and Dental College. AFH is registered with Punjab Healthcare Commission (PHC) and ISO 9001:2015 certified. Ali Fatima hospital (AFH) is a 600 bedded tertiary care hospital located at Raiwind Road, Lahore to address the need of the community as well as to provide training facilities for medical and paramedical personnel. The target population, in general, belongs to a low socio-economic group in and around Lahore with a population of about 30 million.

AFH is fully equipped with the latest diagnostic facilities including Medical Laboratory and

radiology (Ultrasound, Doppler, CT Scan, Mammography, MRI, and Angio-suit). A highly qualified team of doctors and Nursing / Paramedical is working 24/7 to deliver efficient and effective healthcare facilities.

Aside from nearly full occupancy of beds indoors, more than 1100 patients benefit from the outdoors on a daily basis. The OPD is housed in a fully constructed, air-conditioned structure. Outdoor services are provided by both on-call consultants and visiting consultants. Internal Medicine, General Surgery, Gynecology and obstetrics, Eye, ENT, Nephrology, Urology, Dermatology, Psychiatry, Dental & Maxillofacial Surgery, Physiotherapy, and Nutrition are among the fields that offer outpatient treatments. In the OPD, there is also the option of collecting lab samples on the spot. Outpatient services are provided to patients at no cost. Free medicines are given to the poor and needy patients.





Facilities

Infrastructure:

The campus is situated on 70 kanals of land with a covered area of more than 150,000 sq ft., in the heart of the educational hub of Lahore with very easy access on the main Raiwind road Lahore, having state of the art infrastructure, which include academic blocks, sports grounds, library, cafeteria, girls' hostel, mosque, labs, and Ali Fatima Teaching Hospital.

Auditorium:

The campus has a fully furnished, centrally airconditioned auditorium with a seating capacity of more than 500 people for conducting various events like seminars, conferences, and lectures, etc. The auditorium is well equipped with the latest Audio/Visual system.

Library:

Libraries serve the community with up-to-date information through different sources. The campus has a digital library, online research journals, periodicals. All users from faculty, staff, or students are encouraged to make full use of available resources. It contains around 1700 books on medical and allied health sciences subjects.

Internet facilities in the library connect users & provide access to books, journals, theses, newspapers, and other resources in a hybrid environment (i.e., a combination of print and online resources). AUMDC library has access to the Higher Education Commission (HEC) Digital Library that provides thousands of virtual reference sources, online books, electronic journals, digital theses, and other multimedia resources on various subjects. The library is equipped with the latest technology like KOHA Library Management System and is providing users the facility of borrowing and returning library material. The bibliographic information about available collections is available through KOHA software.

Comfortable interior and innovative furniture in the libraries make them stunning and provide a refreshing environment that attracts users and compels them to spend time and study in a relaxed and conducive environment. Study carrels and study lounge for faculty and students provide an excellent atmosphere.



IT Facilities:

The information & Communication Technology (ICT) department is responsible for ensuring the adequacy of academic and administrative computing facilities at AUMDC. The department implements efficient technology infrastructure, supports an effective campus management system, and delivers responsive IT support services. Wi-Fi cloud computing facility is also available throughout the campus. The network on the campus is based on a fiber-optic backbone and supplemented by high-speed internet access. The campus has two computer labs with more than 200 latest computers.

Lecture Theatres:

The campus has 6 fully air-conditioned, state-of-the-art lecture theatres, equipped with inbuilt Audio/ Visual systems for the effective teaching and learning of the students.

Conference Rooms:

AUMDC has three well-furnished conference rooms with a seating capacity of 20-40 people each. These rooms are fully equipped with the inbuilt Audio/ Visual system for Board/ faculty meetings and for organizing seminars and workshops.



Laboratories:

AUMDC is equipped with state-of-the-art laboratories with a conducive environment for learning. The students have access to the latest equipment for hands-on training and are being taught by using modern audio/ visual aids. Emphasis is given to safe practices during laboratory work.

Hostel:

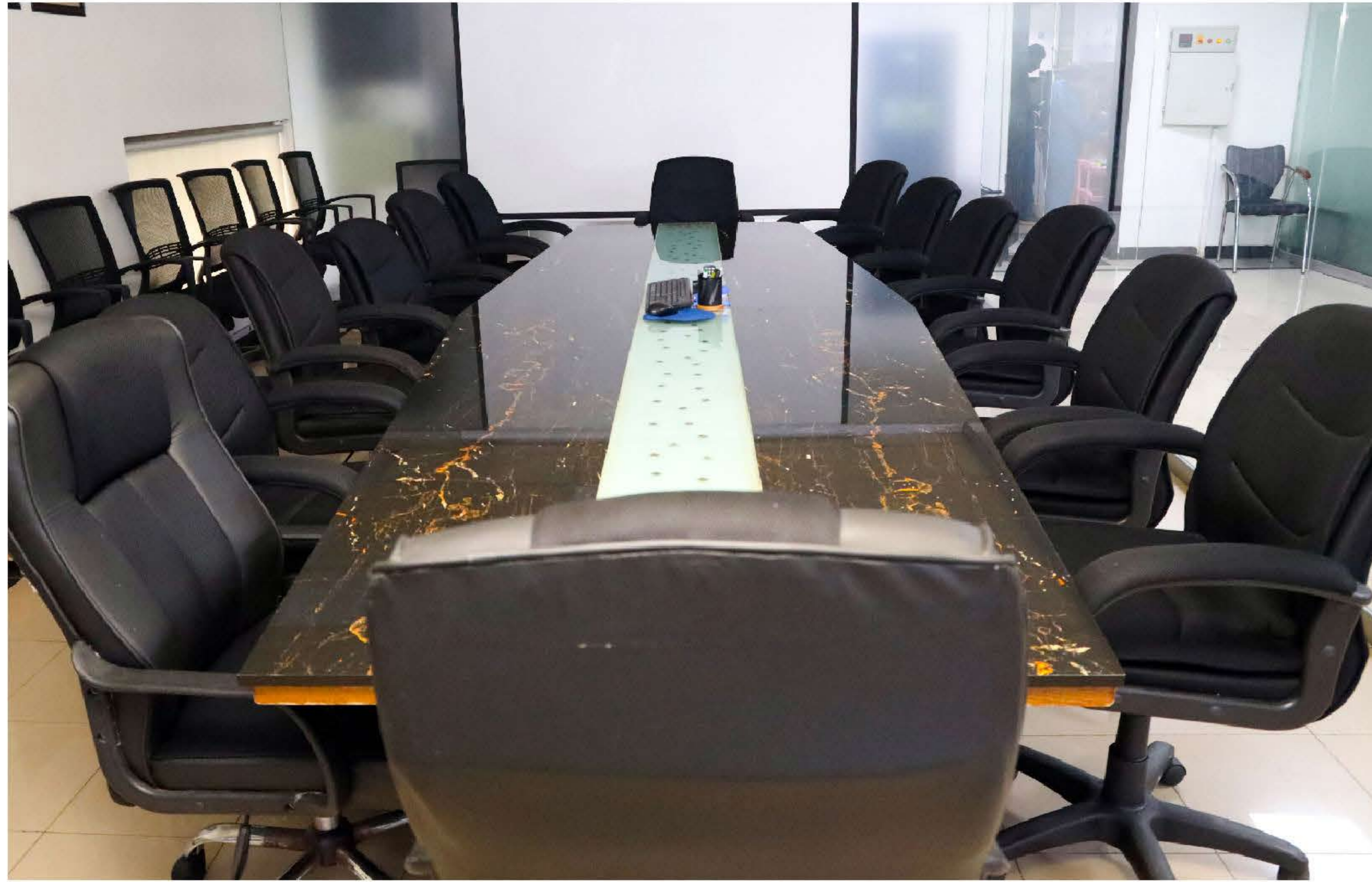
AUMDC has an on-campus hostel facility for girls. The students are given the facility of accommodation, mess, and internet facility.

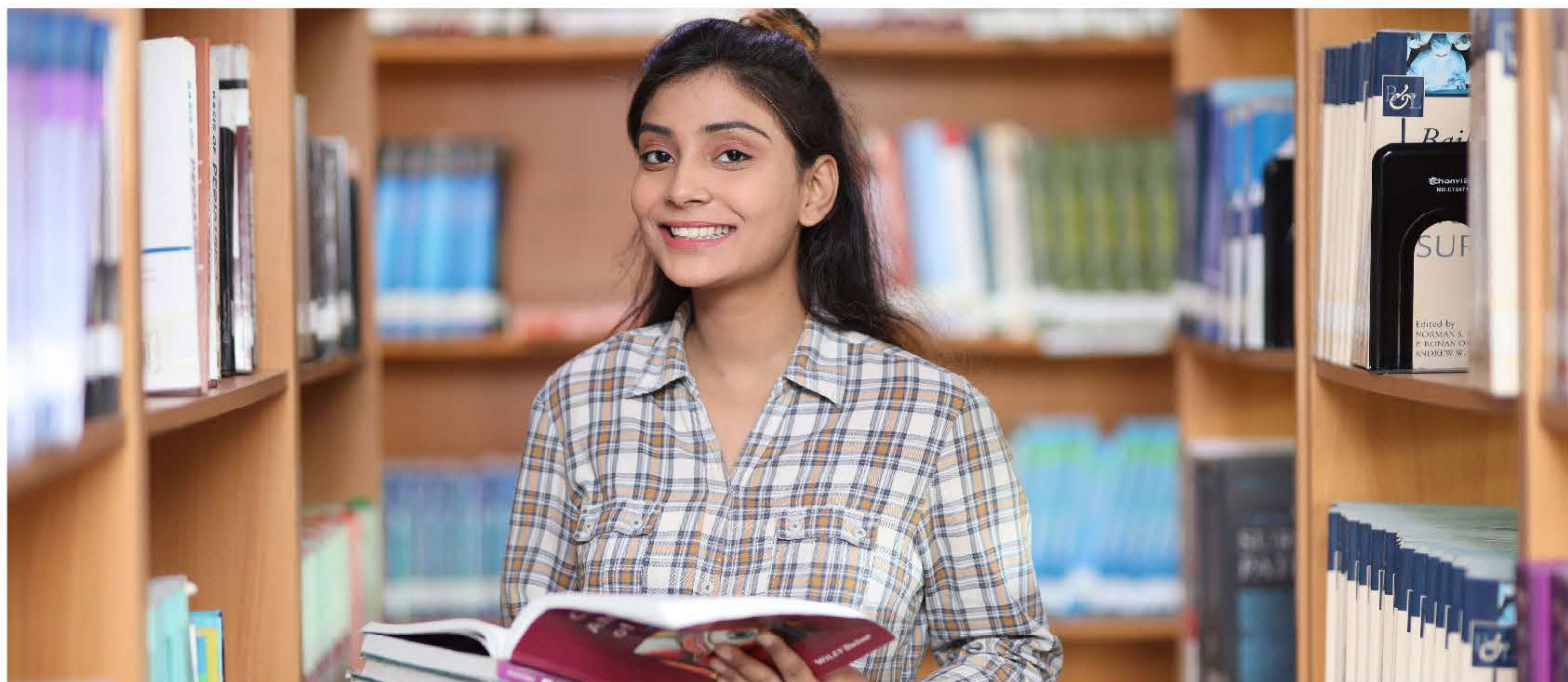
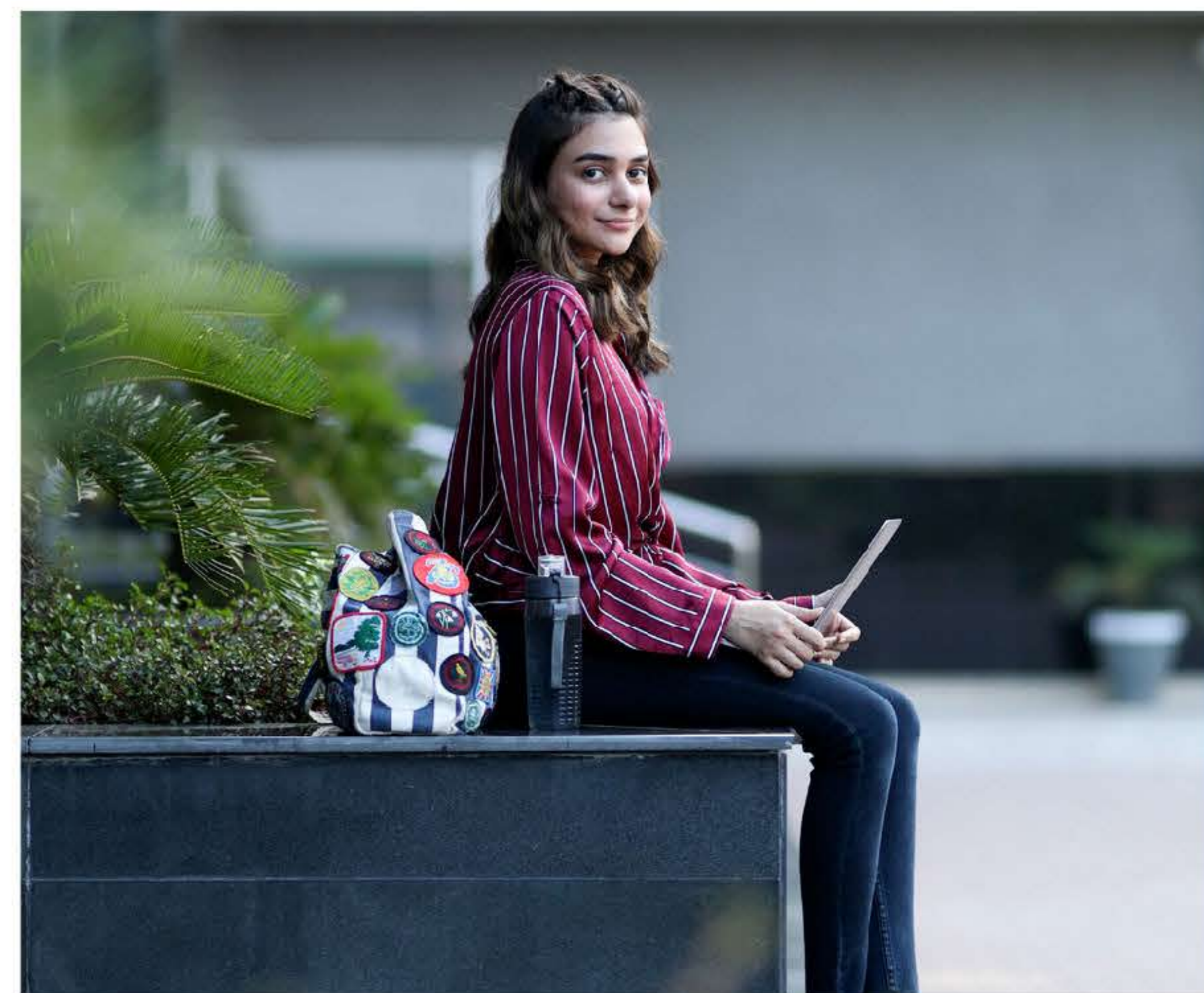

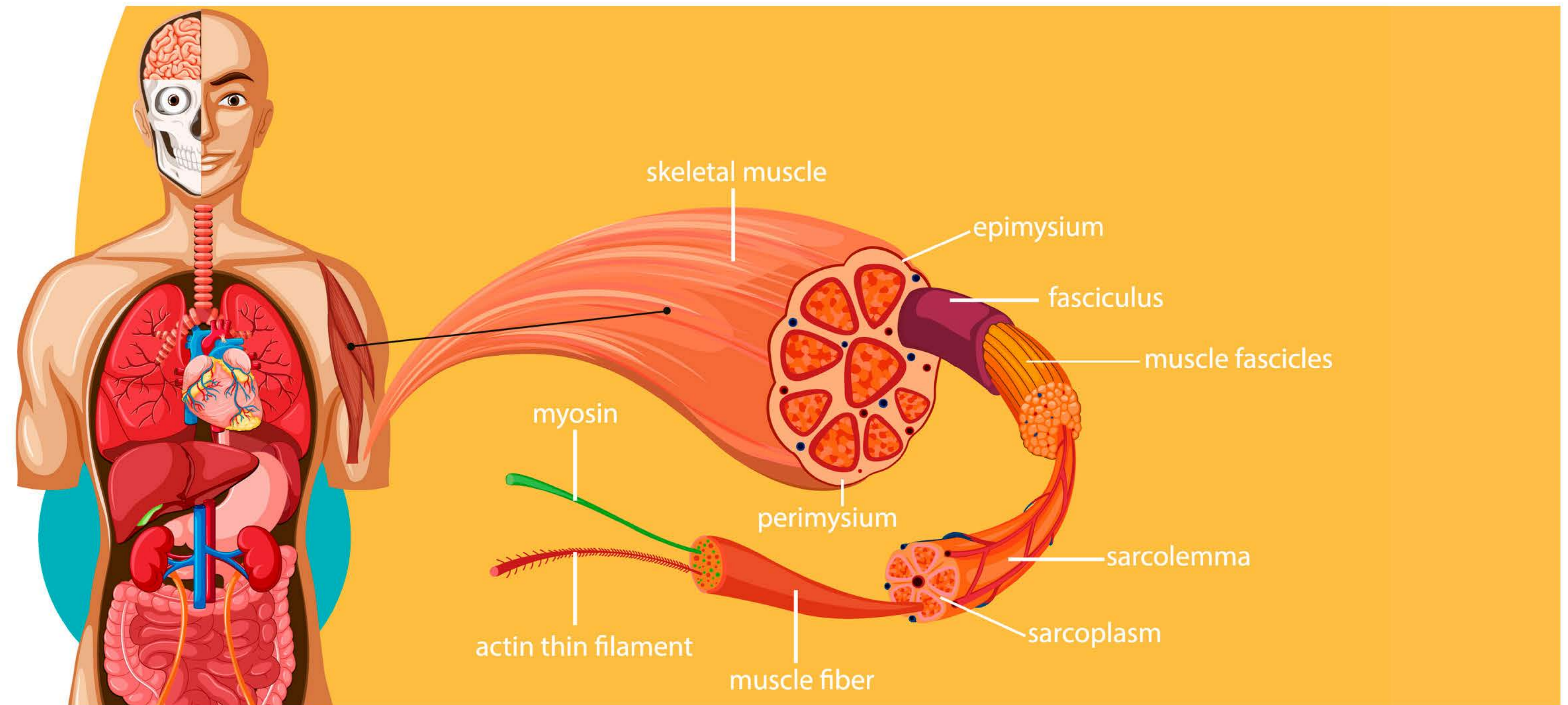

DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY

Introduction:

The Department of Biochemistry aims to provide high-quality education to students studying MBBS and a variety of other Allied Health Sciences. The aim is to educate medical and allied health professionals with better understanding of Biochemistry and to provide scientific manpower that can better serve the community. Department is also offering BS, MPhil and PhD degrees in Biochemistry. The novel research in this area will add the foundation of knowledge and improve the quality of life. Students in this department will be a source of pride for the college and university by making significant contributions to national growth.

The course of Biochemistry aims to give the students an understanding of the structure, function and working of human body at cellular, sub cellular and molecular level, both in health as well as disease. The course is structured into several distinct portions in order to provide a logical approach to the subject: • Molecular Biochemistry • Nutritional Biochemistry • Metabolism • Clinical and Applied Biochemistry • Biochemical Genetics • Molecular Endocrinology • Molecular Cell Biology Laboratory practical classes are held to assist in elucidating the concepts discussed in lectures and seminars. Students are introduced to methods of biochemical investigations, relevant to clinical sciences. They are also introduced to the concepts of clinical biochemistry, in which measurement of bio-molecules is used for diagnosis and monitoring of the diseased states. Modern techniques used in the clinical service and basic research laboratories are introduced with hands on various procedures to familiarize the students with scientific basis of modern methods along with their limitations and facilities.

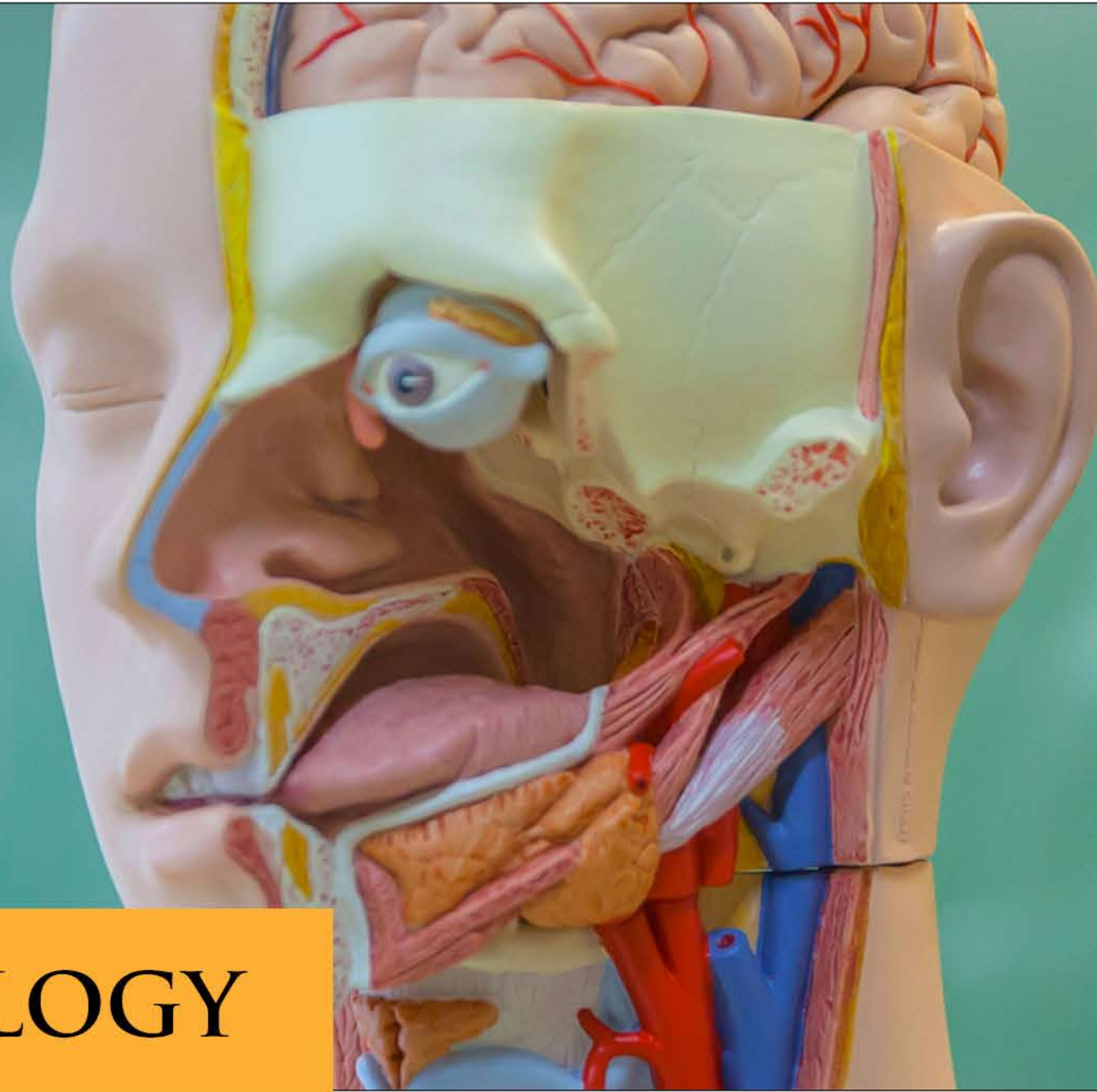
Department of Biochemistry

The subject of Pathology is bridge between basic and clinical subjects. It takes students from Morbid Anatomy to Surgical Pathology, Histology to Histopathology, normal body functioning and biochemistry to etiology and pathogenesis of diseases. The Pathology department is located at fourth floor of Abu Umara Medical and Dental Collage. Whereas state of art Clinical and Haematological Laboratory ia at Ali Fatima Teaching Hospital Lahore.

The main Pathology department comprises of student's teaching Labs, multimedia installed tutorial, conferences rooms and modern Pathology lecture theatres. The Microbiology and Histopathology Labs are functional in Pathology Department. The Haematological, Clinical, Chemical, Immunological, Blood Bank and specialized tests services are available at Ali Fatima Hospital Lab under the supervision of consultants in each field.

The achievements of Pathology department comprises of recognition of Blood Bank form Punjab Blood Transfusion Authority, and Laboratories from Punjab Health Care Commission. The Labs have active Internal Quality Assurance and external Quality Assurance Programs. Our next step is to complete ISO Medical Laboratories Accreditation 15189.

DEPARTMENT OF FORENSIC MEDICINE & TOXICOLOGY

Introduction:

The subject of Forensic Medicine is not only necessary for criminal investigations, but it is extremely vital in making any doctor realize his responsibilities and authorities. Important activities in the life of any practicing doctor at any stage of his career, ranging from taking valid legal consents before treatments, to even working alongside investigation agencies for Autopsies. This subject comprehensively covers all these aspects and spreads into almost every branch of medicine.

The Department of Forensic Medicine at Abu Umara Medical College, Lahore, is at par with any leading Medical Institution of this city. The museum is equipped with models of all commonly observed injuries. A wide variety of Toxicological specimens, including organic, corrosive, and metallic poisons, is also on display for students. Serological samples in the form of microscopic glass slides are also available in a vast variety. Wood's Lamps and a state-of-the-art Spectroscope is also a part of the Museum. Models of Firearm and other weapons are also available. The Museum also has Radiographs that are meant to train students to assess age, gender and extent of injuries using plain X-rays.

Keeping in mind the importance of Medicolegal and Autopsy examinations in our Judicial system, all the students shall undergo a mandatory rotation at the Department of Forensic Medicine, Post Graduate Medical Institute, Lahore. They will be observing Autopsies and Medicolegal Examinations being conducted, in order to prepare for the tough but responsible tasks of Medical Jurisprudence. Visits to the Session Court Lahore, High Court Lahore, Punjab Forensic Science Agency and Office of Surgeon Medicolegal Punjab are also in the pipeline, in order to familiarize the students with the Medicolegal system of Pakistan.

We take great pride in claiming to be amongst the first few departments of Forensic Medicine (along with Agha Khan University, Karachi, DOW Medical University Karachi, NUMS Rawalpindi) that are successfully integrating the subject in a Systems-Based Modular Format.

A doctor must serve all patients regardless of ethnic, racial, religious and

economic ability of patients. The doctor must ensure that a full range of treatment will be dispensed in ways that are complementary, integrated and continuous.

OUTCOME 2: DECISION MAKER (Skills, Attitude):

They will have to take decisions that can be justified in terms of efficacy and cost. They have to choose the most appropriate and the best decisions for their patient. And they have to know the negative and the positive impact for the decision they have been taken. The decisions taken must be the best decisions according to the existing condition.

OUTCOME 3: COMMUNICATOR (Attitude):

Our graduate would be a good communicator in order to persuade individuals, families and the communities to adopt healthy lifestyles. Communications skills are essential for medical practice. It is a backbone over which lot of areas of patient care rests such as, first contact patient interviews, probing for associated and additional problems, counseling the patient, explaining treatment options, its complications and advising follow-up. It is also necessary for explaining risks to the patient, counseling in case of bereavement or mishap, providing information about a surgical procedure its complications, taking an informed consent.

OUTCOME 4: COMMUNITY LEADER (Knowledge, Skills, Attitude):

Our graduate would be a good community leader. Leadership and management skills are required to ensure the provision of high-quality patient care. Clinical quality depends on inter-professional teamwork, and therefore, leadership and management skills are needed at all levels. Our medical graduates are expected to have skills to deal with and resolve conflicts, learn to share leadership, prepare others to help and replace them, take mutual responsibility and discuss their performance.

OUTCOME 5: MANAGER (Skills, Attitude):

Our graduate would have managerial skills. This skill is very essential for a doctor, because they have to manage, for example, the administrative management of patients, the redemption of prescriptions, etc. Those things are often considered trivial, but if not handled properly, it will complicate the job. This skill would enable them to initiate exchanges of information in order to make better decisions, and to work within a multidisciplinary team in close association with other partners for health and social development.

OUTCOME 6: RESEARCHER (Knowledge, Skills):

Healthcare decision-making is largely reliant on evidence-based medicine and understanding and using scientific methods is an essential skill to acquire for our medical graduates. NOTES:

Admissions will be strictly on merit. Applicants are required to apply online through Online Admission Portal Applicants must completely fill the online application followed by successful submission through online portal. Incomplete applications will not be entertained.

A student when accepting admission to a college shall be under an obligation to disclose to the college if a prior admission has been accepted by them to any other college, and such student shall prior to accepting such latter admission must in writing inform the prior college of cancellation of their acceptance with a copy to the designated email of the Authority. Failure by a student to cancel the prior acceptance of admission shall render all admission offers of the student as void and the student shall be ineligible for admission. (PMDC Admission Regulations dated 13 Jul, 2023)

STUDENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Abu Umara Medical & Dental College Lahore stands committed to impart quality education to students and as part of its curriculum, to develop our students into well-disciplined and responsible professionals having respect for their character and fully accountable for their conduct.
- The achievement of this objective requires persistent devotion and dedication on the part of the students, with their focus on superior behavior and conduct.
- The information given below contains instructions and guidelines which will help the students to achieve the objectives of the "Student Code of Conduct."
- This information contains official policies of the Abu Umara Medical & Dental College Lahore, which the students are required to follow in letter and spirit at all times.
- The College will enforce and implement these policies formally and swift disciplinary action will be taken against any student flouting any of the rules/policies contained herein.

Attendance

- a. In the annual system of education, regular attendance in the classes is essential and monitored to ensure that the student has not missed any Lecture and Practical or fallen behind in her academic work.
- b. As per the university policy, student having less than 85% attendance is not eligible to sit in the Annual Examinations.
- c. Attendance of students is monitored through an online system of roll call in each class by the concerned faculty member.
- d. A latecomer may sit in the class even after the instructor has already marked him/her absent.
- e. Attendance after late arrival does not give the student any right to ask the instructor to mark him/her present.

Punctuality

- a. Students are required to be seated in the specified classroom before the commencement of the class. Students are expected to be quiet and well-behaved.

Dress Code

- a. Students are prohibited from wearing a dress that is provocative or indecent, has any inappropriate script/image, or is not according to local cultural values.
- b. Students should avoid flashy clothes, jewellery, anklet, make-up, open shoes, or shoes with heels producing noise.
- c. Boys must wear dress shoes, and dress shirts with full or half sleeves tucked inside trousers. Neat Shalwar Kameez with waistcoat is also allowed.
- d. All the students must wear white overalls in Laboratories.

Identity Cards

- a. Students are required to display their College Identity Cards prominently all the time while on campus.

No Smoking in Campus

- a. The College is a 'No Smoking area'. Students are strictly forbidden to smoke on the Campus, inside the College premises, Lawn, cafeteria, and on the roads inside the College.

Avoid Politics

- a. Car stickers at nominal cost are available from the College Accounts Office and these stickers are to be displayed on the left top corner of the windscreen.

- a. Loitering and languishing in and around the College premises or lawns in front of the College or corridors etc., is strictly prohibited.
- b. Students may sit on the benches provided throughout the Campus during break time.

- a. Drinks and eatables can be taken only inside the cafeteria.
- b. Eating and drinking at all other places are prohibited.

Social Activities

- a. For all social activities including small parties, written permission of the management will be required.
- b. Students wishing to hold the above should fill in the prescribed form giving details of the event/party, number of students invited/ attending, date, and place of such social event.

Willful Defiance / Disobedience of College Rules / Instructions

- a. Students are expected to read the notices/ instructions daily displayed on the Notice Board.
- b. All notices and instructions must be followed in letter and spirit.
- c. Damage to College Property
- d. Willful damage of any item of the College property is a serious offense.
- e. Students found damaging College property will be required to replace the damaged item and in addition, pay a fine which will be decided by the Disciplinary Committee.

Bullying / Fooling/ Ragging

- a. The College does not allow any kind of bullying, fooling, or ragging with new students.

- a. Sitting or standing in the lobbies outside lecture theatres and labs is not allowed.

Student Visitors

- a. Students are not allowed to entertain visitors or friends in the College or take them around to visit the campus.
- b. Permission must be obtained from the Administration before inviting any guest to the College

- a. Students will not scream or shout or make unnecessary noise in the corridors or the academic block.

Procedure for Meeting Management & Paying Respect & Wishing

- a. Students will pay proper respect and wish Assalam-o-Alaikum to all members of the Management and the Faculty.
- b. All employees of the College will be given due respect and courtesy at all times.

Parking

- g. Violation/damage to the parking area shall cost a penalty of a fine (according to extent of the damage) to the vehicle operator/owner.
- h. Administration and Faculty shall ensure that the policy is implemented in letter and spirit.

Disciplinary Requirements

- a. Every student shall abide by the disciplinary regulations as made from time to time by the management of the College.
- b. All members of the College and other persons authorized for the purpose shall have authority and it shall be their duty to check disorderly or improper conduct or any breach of regulation by students of the College in any of the buildings, including any premises occupied by the students or in the College grounds.

- e. It shall be the duty of all students of the College in all their acts to observe and maintain within the boundaries of the College decent and peaceful behaviour at all times.

Disciplinary Suspension or Dismissal

The College reserves the right to suspend or dismiss a student for violation of policies, regulations, and discipline code or of conduct inimical to the best interest, or for the shortage of attendance, or for attempting to use unfair means during classes, quizzes, or examinations. Management decisions in all student matters shall be final.

Students' Interaction with Faculty

- a. Students' interaction with faculty should be limited to academic pursuits only.
- b. Students are not expected to socialize with faculty and administration staff more than what is necessary for acquiring quality education in the College.
